This is essentially a communication practice course. Zoom has been chosen since it best allows real-time social engagement in English with the teacher and with classmates. However, students need to be aware that their scope for getting the most out of these classes depends on <u>preparation</u> as much as it does on <u>participation</u>. The textbook provides the topic content and related vocabulary/grammar focus for students to complete before each Zoom session. The Zoom session can then review this input quite swiftly, allowing most of the session to be participation in communication. Usually a writing task develops and consolidates ideas that emerged through class discussion. Writing tasks are posted and submitted via Loyola.
