授業の 概要	In this course students will explore the writings of several influential women from different times and places. Students will do active readings of these works in English. They will begin to do independent research on works of literature by exploring a text's style, themes, literary genre, and context and by writing a short research report.							
達成目標	<ul> <li>students will:</li> <li>read short works of life writing and literature written by women (journals, letters, psychological novels, speeches, poetry)</li> <li>closely read a text and analyze its style</li> <li>identify major themes in the text (how does the author feel about the act of writing; what are recurring problems or ideas in the text; what values are important; what view of the world does the author express)</li> <li>begin to situate texts in their contexts (historical, cultural, cultural values, conventions related to a literary genre)</li> <li>begin to explore the different relationships between texts and their contents</li> <li>get familiar with research habits and tools for studying literature.</li> </ul>							
到達目標評価方法	For each of the short texts in the syllabus, students will learn to prepare preliminary research notes related to the text's style and context. Students will begin to do independent research on an author and text. For their research projects, students will analyze the text's style and themes, research the text's context and prepare a research report with a basic thesis statement. They will practice explaining orally their own research process and findings in a presentation.  Participation 40%, Research notes 30%, Report 20%, Report presentation 10%							
評価基準	Participation means active participation in class activities including sharing findings and impressions about the texts during class discussions.  Research notes should be made thoroughly for each short text we will read. The research notes are due at the beginning of the class in which the text is assigned.  The report should demonstrate the student's effort to identify major themes in the chosen text and to notice some elements of style in the text. The report should contain relevant information to situate the text in its context. It should have a basic thesis statement.  Presentation should intelligibly explain the topic chosen for research, what tools were used for research and what the research findings were.
