授業の 概要	This class will help students develop the skills needed to express themselves in a variety of genres of written English. Students will build their writing skills from sentences, to paragraphs, to complete texts.							
達成目標	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>For students to gain a command of the skills necessary to write in a range of genres of English</li> <li>For students to acquire an understanding of the importance of register in writing</li> <li>For students to acquire the ability to express themselves logically and creatively in written English</li> </ul>							
到達目標	By the end of this course students should be able to (1) write logical and clear sentences, (2) write coherently structured paragraphs, (3) express themselves in creative writing tasks such as writing stories, poems and scripts.							
評価方法	Participation (10%), Homework (15%): worksheets, Writing assignments (75%): 7 paragraph writing tasks, newspaper article, poem/lyrics, script, story.							
評価基準	Participation: active involvement, effort to communicate; Homework: completed on time, effort to complete by self; Written assignments: submitted on time, use of vocabulary, grammar (logical and clear sentences) and organization (coherently structured paragraphs), creativity (originality, development of ideas, clear intentions)							
準備学修 の時間	For each 90-minute class session of this course, an average of 45 minutes is needed for out-of-class study (assignments, review, etc.).
